We, AOTS has been providing an opportunity for young people in emerging countries to understand both modern and traditional Japan, promote friendship with Japan and develop as a bridge between 2 countries.

Towards this purpose, this 5 days program is full of unique and attractive activities, which would be difficult to experience by other programs. To deepen your understanding on traditional Japan, we will prepare the opportunities for basic Japanese lesson and actual experience of Japanese cultures (Ikebana/Fieldwork in Kamakura, etc.) as well as 1 day bus tour of Mt. Fuji (World Heritage)/Snow experience. While, from the aspect of modern and advanced Japan, you will have the opportunities to visit Japanese corporations (factories). In addition to that, we will give you the opportunity for presentation & debate with our AOTS staff in order to develop your personal capabilities such as leadership/teamwork as well as fostering friendship with us.

We hope that being a part of a program will be beneficial for your personal development as well as future career development with Japan.

(Teacher will give you some handouts written in English and Japanese to the lesson.)

 - Japanese Corporation/Facility Visits (Factories of major Japanese corporations, JAXA Tsukuba Space Center)
- ◆ For developing personal capabilities (leadership/teamwork):
 - Fieldwork at Kamakura
 - Final Presentation by participants
